

COOKIE POLICY

Introduction

This policy is also made available, pursuant to article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2017/679 "Protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data" (hereinafter GDPR), to users who interact with the web services of Sodai SpA, accessible via the internet at the address: https://sodai.com/.

The data controller is Sodai S.p.A., with registered offices in Milan, Via R. Montecuccoli, 32.

Through this policy, we intend to provide you with some information on the technology adopted and how it is used on our website. Some important aspects to understand about the use of this technology are summarised below.

What are cookies?

Like almost all websites, we use small data files, which are stored on your computer, tablet, mobile phone or other mobile device (collectively referred to as "device") to record certain data each time you access or interact with our websites, services, apps, messaging systems and tools.

The specific names and types of cookies used may change over time. To help you better understand the regulations and the use of cookies, here are some terms with their definitions:

<u>Cookie</u>: small text files (usually in the form of letters and numbers) which are stored in the browser memory of the device when you visit a website or view a message. Cookies allow a website to recognise a particular device or browser. There are different types of cookies:

- temporary (or session): they are used to store temporary information, allow you to link your actions during that specific session and are removed from the computer when Internet Explorer is closed;
- permanent (or saved): they are used to store information, e.g. the login name and password, so the user does not have to re-enter them every time he/she visits a specific website; they remain stored on the computer even after closing Internet Explorer;
- first-party: they derive from the website displayed and can be permanent or temporary; they can be used to store information that will be reused on the next visit to the website;
- third-party: they derive from advertisements from other websites, such as pop-ups or advertising banners, present on the website displayed; they can be used to record the use of the website for marketing purposes.

Cookies can be disabled or removed using the tools available in most browsers. Cookie preferences must be set separately for each browser used because each of them offers specific features and options.

The cookies on our website

Our cookies are used to ensure that our website is working properly.

We use technical cookies that remain on your device only for as long as you are browsing (session cookies).

You can block, delete or disable them if your device allows it. You can manage cookies and cookie preferences in your device or browser settings.

Cookie categories

Technical cookies



They are used to ensure the correct functioning of our services and to allow us to improve performance. This technology allows our websites, services, apps and tools to store important information in your browser or device and then, use it later to identify you on our servers or internal systems. Where applicable, we protect cookies to ensure that only Sodai S.p.A. and/or our authorised service providers can interpret them by assigning them a unique code. Your personal data are not stored in cookies or other similar data used.

All the personal data acquired and stored using this technology is obtained only after providing you with a specific policy.

The uses of this technology fall under the following general categories:

Necessary use from an operational point of view. The use of cookies may be necessary for website operation, services, apps and tools. This includes technology that allows the user to access the websites, services, apps and tools required to avoid fraudulent activity and improve security or to use other functions such as shopping carts, saved searches or similar functions.

Use for performance purposes. We may use cookies to assess the performance of our websites, apps, tools and services, including analytical activities to understand how visitors use our websites, determine if they have interacted with our messaging system or viewed an item or link, or to improve the website's content, apps, services or tools.

Use related to functionality. We may use cookies to offer you advanced functions when accessing or using our websites, services, apps or tools. Thanks to these functions, we can, for example, identify users who access our websites or monitor their preferences, interests or previously viewed objects, in order to improve the presentation of content on our websites.

Consent for the use of these cookies is not mandatory. If you do not want to accept the use of technical cookies, you can disable them as indicated above; in this case you may not be able to take advantage of certain functions, services, apps or tools of the website. The site may ask you to re-enter your password several times during the same session.
